

Panic Device with Lever

Grade 1 rim-type panic with exterior key-in-lever trim. Meets ADA requirements



Ball-Bearing Hinges

Full mortise 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" ball bearing hinges with non-removable pin.



Latch Guard

Highly recommended for added security at minimal expense. Steel plate prevents latch tampering.

Lever Lock

Mortise Lock with Lever

Intended for heavy use and added security. Combines the benefits of lock and deadbolt functions. Meets

ADA requirements.



18-Gage Door

Upgrade from standard 20 gage door. Recommended for heavy use applications.



Textured Door Skin

Available in lieu of the standard 20 gage smooth skin door. May help camoflage small nicks and dents.
